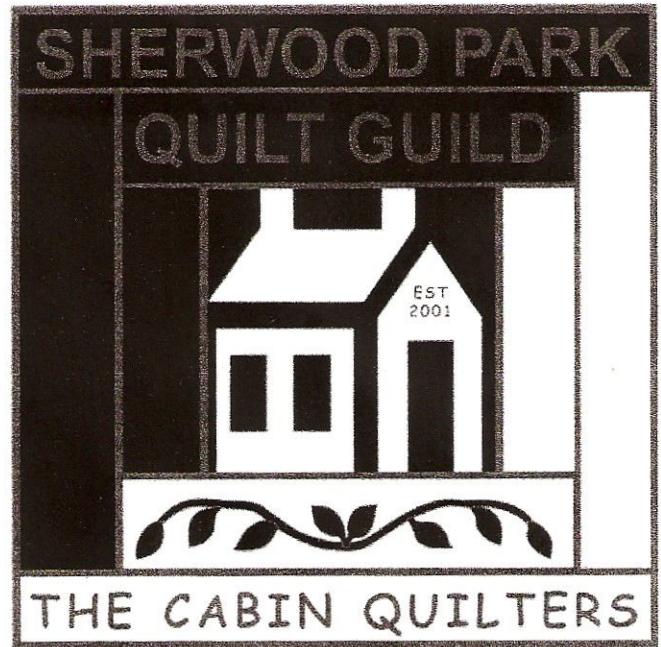


## Sherwood Park Quilters Guild - Stash Bustin Challenge.

*This challenge won't cost you a penny. Stash busting challenges are popular at the moment so here is one just for us.*

### Here are the rules:

1. **It must be a quilt** i.e. have 3 layers that are held together with quilting stitches. It may be anything from a King Size Bed Quilt to a tiny wall hanging, It can be flat or 3 dimensional. It can be clothing. Choice is up to you.
2. To be eligible for a prize it must be present at the May meeting.
3. It must be made in 2009. Finishing UFO's, PIP's, PhD's do not count UNLESS they were started as a stash busters..
4. It must be made from your stash or that of a fellow quilter. How you get it from his/her stash is up to you but you cannot pay her for it. Repurposing fabric bought for projects never begun and that you really don't want to make any more is OK. There are no rules regarding swapping, raiding your friends stash or taking a chunk of someone's shirt if it is the colour you need. But you may not pay money.
5. It must have the colours (red, blue, white and gold) of the Sherwood Park Quilt Guild somewhere on the front in any amount  
And/or  
A house block the same as or similar to the logo somewhere on the front.
6. If you have to buy batting for your stash buster quilt we will allow that. But you cannot buy backing or binding or boarders.
